The Jet Propulsion Lab--owned by NASA and managed by the nearby California Institute of Technology--is a federally funded research and development center. The laboratory's primary function is the construction and operation of planetary robotic spacecraft, although it also conducts earth-orbit and astronomy missions. Dr. Dusan Petrac obtained his Ph.D in physics at UCLA. His work at JPL included missions such as IRAS, Spitzer Space Telescope, Plank and Space Shuttle-borne experiments.
