The general public may know Rich Pfeiffer as the attorney who helped former Manson follower, Leslie Van Houten, get approval for parole in September 2017 after serving 40 years for the murder of Rosemary LaBianca. While Leslie has been approved as suitable for release by the parole board, she is awaiting approval by Governor Brown. His decision is expected any day now. Pfeiffer began his legal career after a successful appeal releasing him from prison due to addiction-related criminal charges in the 1980s. Last month Rich received a pardon from Governor Brown for the crime that sent him to prison. A former Navy SEAL Team member and national champion in aviation sports (sky diving, hang gliding), Pfeiffer's past often motivates clients to become successful despite having made mistakes.
