At the age of 10 years, East German-born Preu became a member, soloist and assistant conductor of the Boys Choir Dresdner Kreuzchor. He earned his Master's Degree in Conducting in Weimar and also studied at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique de Paris. Preu came to the US as winner of the National Conducting Competition of the German Academic Exchange Service in 1966. He is Music Director, Resident Conductor and Guest Conductor of numerous orchestras around the world.
