Vice Mayor Rex Richardson was elected to the Long Beach City Council in 2014 to represent the neighborhoods of North Long Beach in District 9, becoming the youngest in the City's history to have ever served in that role. In July 2016 he was elected Vice Mayor, making him the youngest to serve as Vice Mayor in the City's history. He has been leading North Long Beach on a "Roadmap to its Renaissance" by placing a focus on economic and community revitalization. Vice Mayor Richardson recently launched #EveryoneIn, an initiative designed to create a local economy that includes and benefits every Long Beach resident.
