

CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP

Basic criteria for consideration of membership in the Rotary Club of Long Beach shall follow the general principles outlined in the Rotary International Constitution, as well as the following requirements, which shall be adopted or modified by each year's board of directors.

It is understood that the purpose of stating our criteria is in no way meant to create barriers or a time-consuming process, but rather to clarify and strengthen the role of the membership process and to remove ambiguity or unnecessary or inappropriate roadblocks.

- 1. Proposals for membership should be submitted only for prospects with good character and reputation in their business and personal life.
- 2. Prospects should be provided with a copy of the Four-Way Test and affirm that they will follow the concepts therein.
- 3. Prospective members shall have attended a Rotary Revealed information meeting followed by a minimum of two club lunches and one other club function prior to submission of Membership Proposal form.

Any exceptions to these criteria may be made by approval of the Membership Chair and the President, particularly for returning or transferring Rotarians that were/are active members.
