Project must occur before December 31, 2025. If a Grant is awarded, the Long Beach Rotary Charitable Foundation logo must be placed on any and all marketing and promotional materials for the project/event, on any and all signage for the event and on any and all clothing for the project/event. We welcome you to invite Rotarians to attend your event, just provide us with the date, time and location. **Submission Deadline is May 24, 2025.**
